RESOLUTION NO. 9822

A RESOLUTION determining that a portion of an existing water easement located at 8000 NE 16th Street is surplus to the City's needs and is no longer required for providing continued public utility service; and setting a time and place for a public hearing to consider the partial release of this easement.

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2008, the City of Bellevue was granted a water easement on the property located at 8000 NE 16th Street in Bellevue, Washington, bearing King County Recording Number 20080521000637; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the property subject to the easement, has requested the City partially release the existing water easement bearing King County Recording Number 20080521000637 (as depicted on Attachment A) because it interferes with the development of the property and a replacement easement will be granted; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Utility Department has verified and confirmed that the aforementioned water easement is no longer required to provide continued public utility services; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the existing water easement (as depicted on Attachment A) is no longer needed by the City and is otherwise surplus property interests; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Bellevue City Code 4.32.070 and RCW 35.94.040, the City Council desires to set a time and place for a public hearing to consider the release of said easement; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Bellevue City Code 4.32.070 and RCW 35.94.040, the City Council of the City of Bellevue does hereby declare a portion of the existing water easement bearing King County Recording Number 20080521000637 (as depicted on Attachment A) as surplus to the needs of the City.

Section 2. A public hearing shall be held upon the proposal to release the easement set forth in Section 1, on November 2, 2020 at 6:00 pm or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, at Bellevue City Hall, 450 110th Avenue NE, Bellevue, Washington or virtually via Zoom Webinar. Details on how to provide

written or oral communications at the public hearing will be provided on the published agenda.
