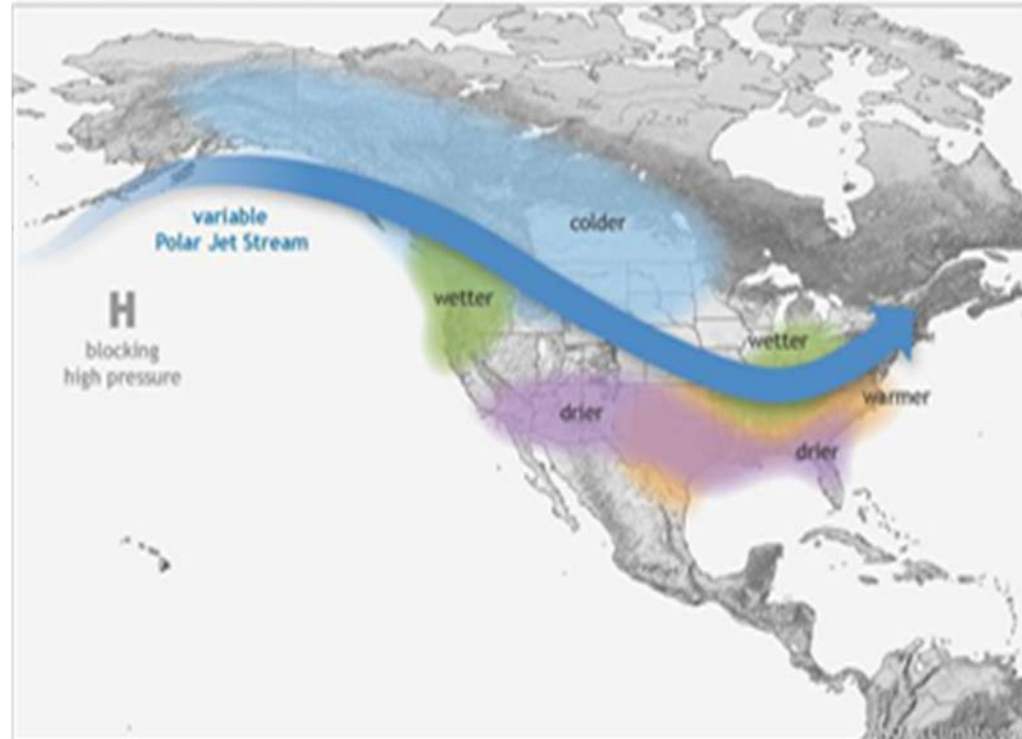

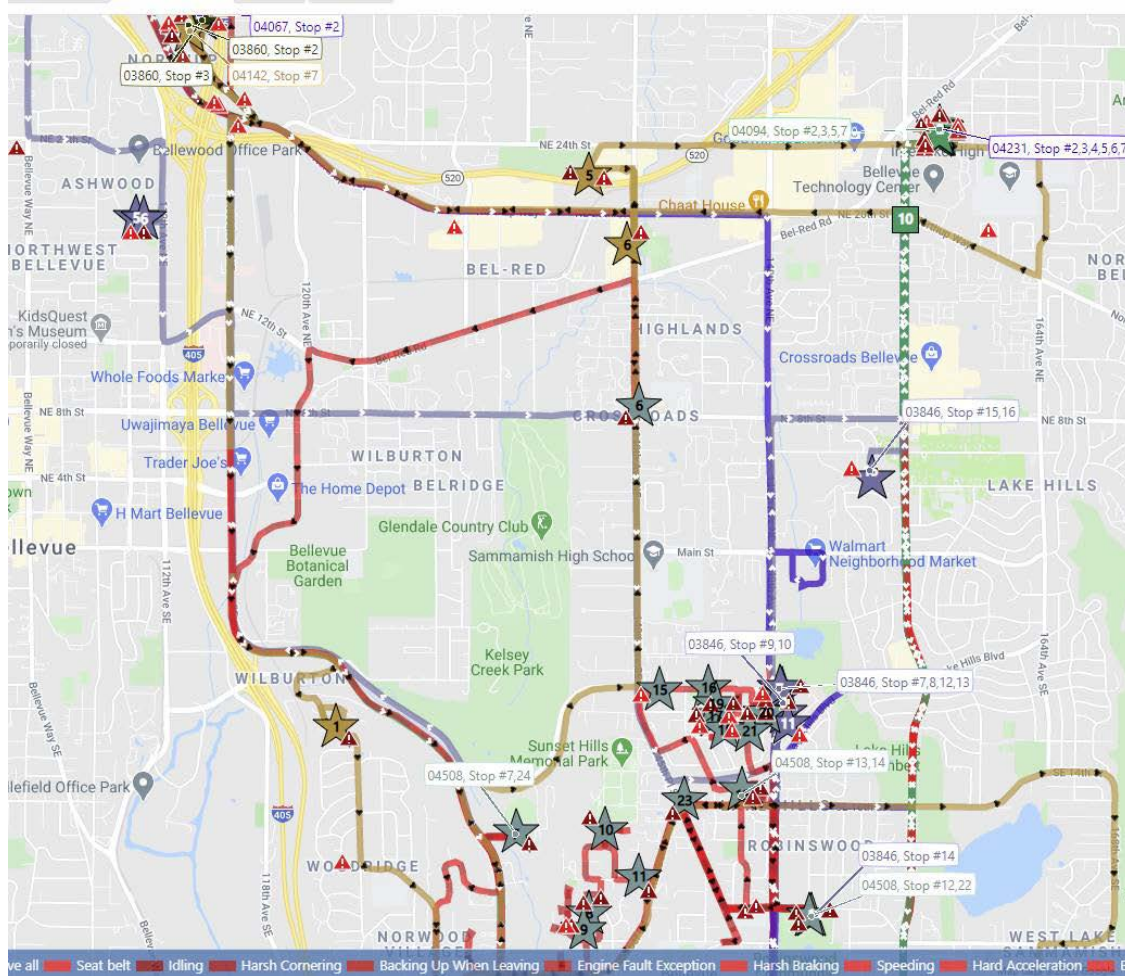


Last Winter's Storm

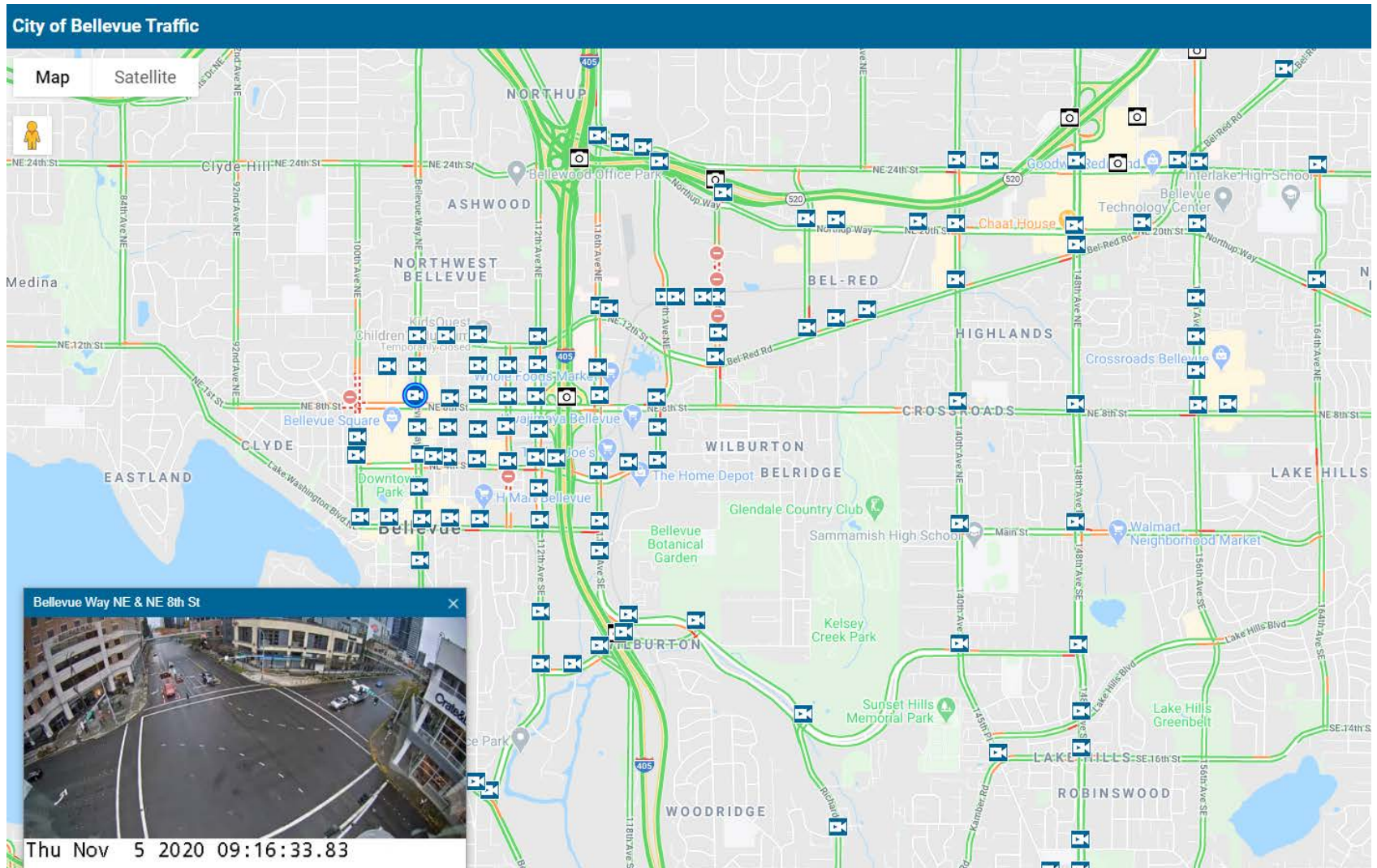
- One 5-day snow event
