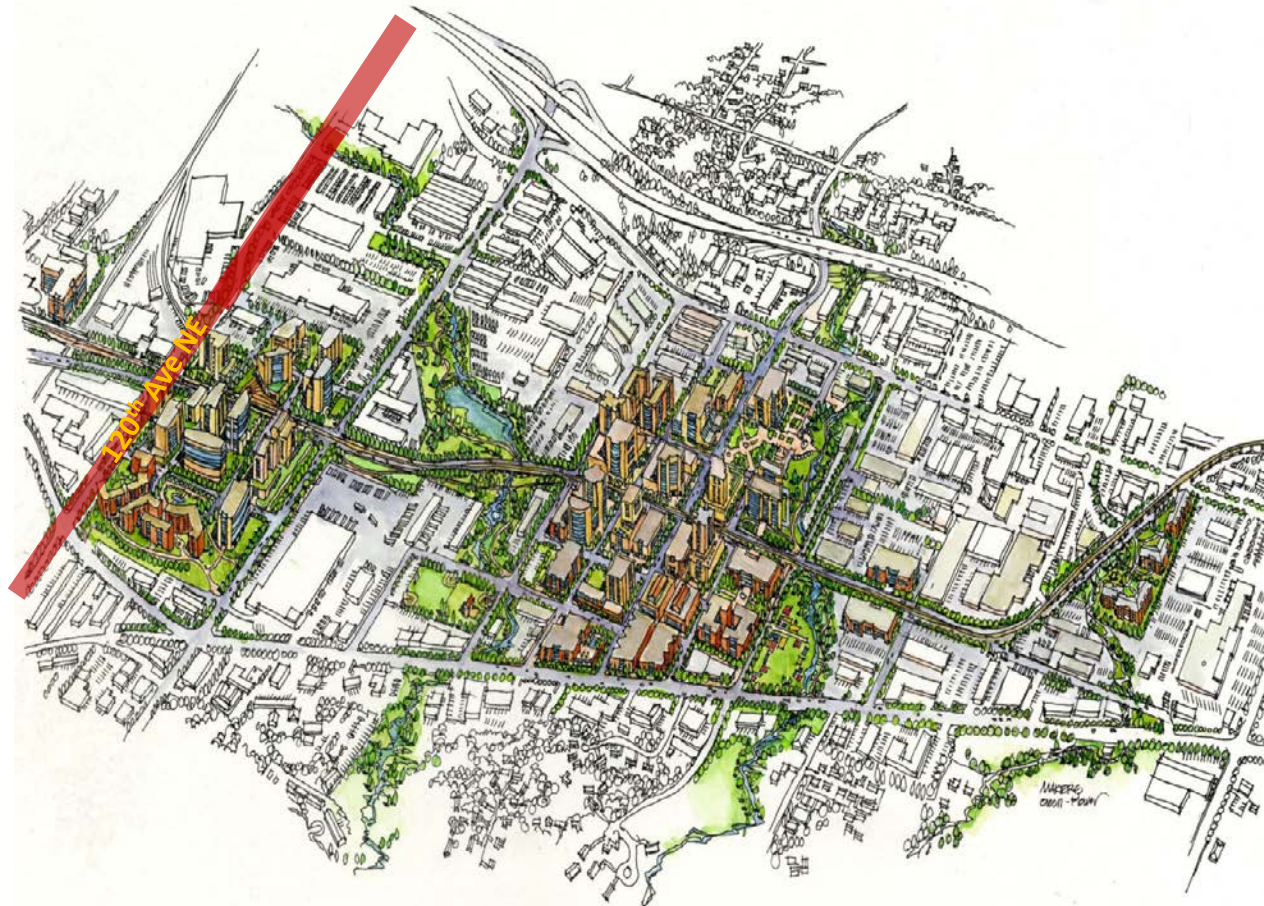
# 120<sup>TH</sup> Avenue NE is a key, central corridor for Bellevue and the east side

## Growth and development



Projected Growth	2035
Office Space	4.1 msf
Retail Space	730 ksf
Multi-Family Units	5,700
Jobs	13,000

# **120<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE Stage 3** (NE 12<sup>th</sup> Street to NE 16<sup>th</sup> Street)

- This project:
  - Widened roadway from 2-lane to 4-lane, plus center turn lane.
  - Extended and connected new sidewalks and bicycle lanes.
  - Built a bridge over the East Link light rail line.
  - Provided roadway vertical realignment, stormwater, and utilities.
  - Added access to development of core business areas.

**Designed through 2013, Constructed 2015-2017**

**Completed on time and under budget**

# **120<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE Stage 3** (NE 12<sup>th</sup> Street to NE 16<sup>th</sup> Street)

## **Recognizing our funding, provided through partnerships, grants, and the City:**

- \$ 8.6 million from Sound Transit
- \$ 4.4 million from a Federal Highway Administration grant
- \$ 3.8 million from a State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) grant
- \$ 3.5 million from the City of Bellevue

-----

- \$20.3 million total construction
