

Council Resolution No. 8229 sets forth policies and procedures for naming public parks and recreation facilities. Council normally selects a park name after receiving a recommendation from the Park Board, which is based upon public input using the following criteria:

- a neighborhood or geographical identification;
- a natural feature;
- a historical figure or name of historical or cultural significance; or
- an individual or group that has made a significant contribution to the park system.

designate the name of the new park.








Neighborhood Historical Figures

Shannon O'Neil Previous owner of the property and prominent NH's family




Chip Hanauer Grew up in Newport Hills, famous hydroplane racer and local celebrity.
