## Transportation Facilities Plan Survey - 2019-2030 Update - Transportation Commission

## Introduction

The Bellevue Transportation Department is updating the Transportation Facilities Plan (TFP). The TFP is a 12-year transportation program of high-priority projects recommended by the Bellevue Transportation Commission and approved by the City Council. The TFP is updated every two to three years and is typically the first step in getting a transportation project funded and built. For the process of developing the new 2019-2030 TFP, the City is reviewing current project priorities and identifying new priority projects. Only a portion of identified needs can be accommodated with the funding anticipated to be available in the 12-year horizon of the TFP.

This 2-minute survey asks about your use of the transportation system in Bellevue. The Transportation Commission will consider public input, together with technical analysis of projects to be performed by City staff, in developing the final recommended list of projects for inclusion in the new TFP. At the conclusion of the survey, you will find a link to an online interactive map where you can view and comment on candidate projects.
