
Where do we stand today in King County?

- Cases are very high. The 14 day incidence rate is over 250/100K; our goal is less than 25/100K. Hospitalizations are also increasing to the highest level since April.
- Avoid gathering indoors, wear masks, increase ventilation, stay six feet apart, get tested at the first sign of illness or close contact of a known case. It's more important than ever.
- BIPOC communities continue to experience disproportionate impacts of COVID-19.
- The most common presumed exposures include household transmission, community & social gatherings, and non-health-care workplaces.
- Vaccine is starting to arrive in King County. Workers at high risk in health care settings and long term care facilities are prioritized in this initial vaccine roll out.
- New testing sites are being added regularly. New sites in Enumclaw and Bellevue have recently come online.
