City of Bellevue Affordable Housing Strategy








Proposed Unit Lot Subdivision LUCA


- Amend LUC 20.45A Platting and Subdivisions and 20.45B Short Plats and Short Subdivisions to allow fee-simple ownership
- Allow Unit Lot Subdivisions in land use districts where multifamily development may be built (approx. 17% of the City)





Proposed Unit Lot Subdivision LUCA Cont'd

- Allow creation of a "parent" lot for overall site and individual "unit" lots for townhomes
- Apply development standards to the parent lot





Anticipated Outcomes

- Encourage infill development and increase the overall number of housing units in Bellevue
- Create individual fee-simple ownership opportunities
- No change to the allowed density
- No change to the appearance of townhouse development allowed by current zoning requirements
