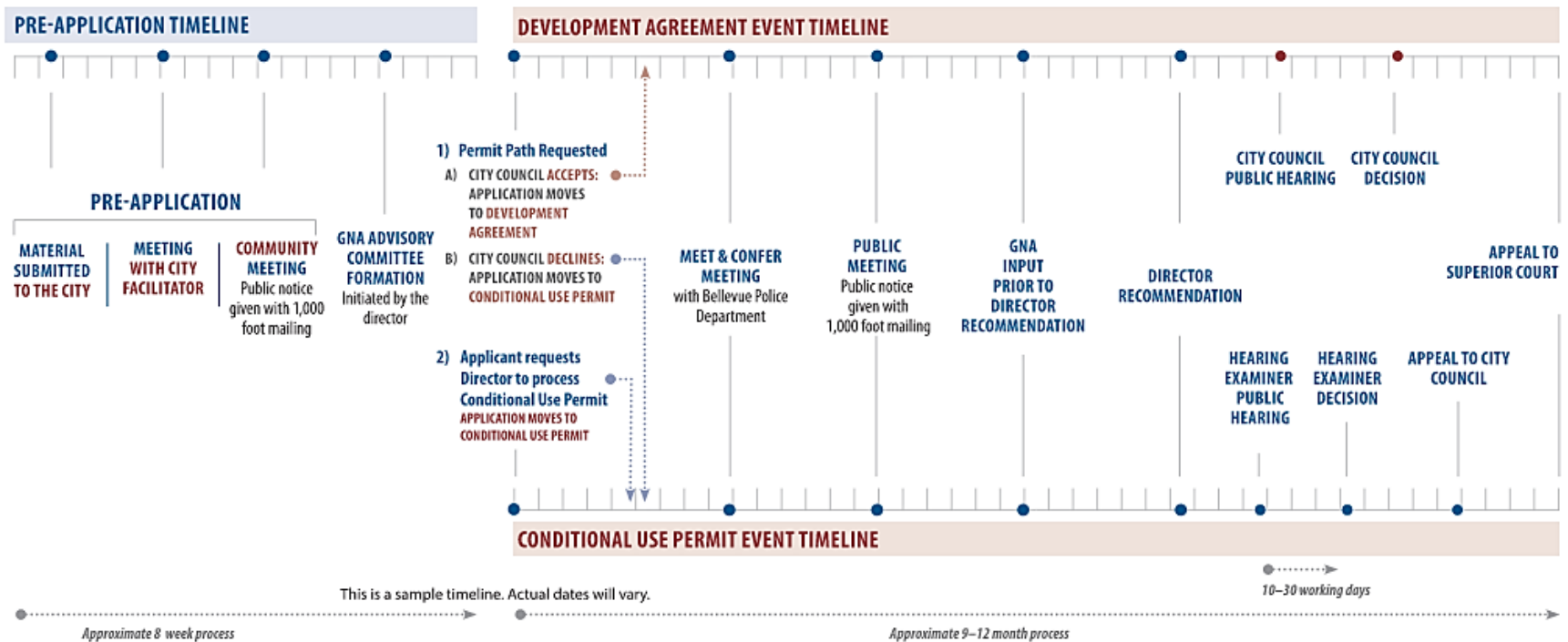

Good Neighbor Agreement Advisory Committee (GNAAC)

- In 2018, Council adopted the Homeless Services Uses Land Use Code Amendment via Ordinance 6419
- Set the regulatory framework for Homeless Services Uses
- GNAAC composition prescribed by the Land Use Code



Purpose of the GNAAC

Purpose of the GNAAC is to foster communication between the community and homeless services operator.

- a. Represents the community, neighborhood and Citywide interests.
- b. Ensures that issues of importance are identified early in the approval process.
- c. Considers the community and adjacent land uses in the area
- d. Provides design guidance
- e. GNAAC participation is streamlined and integrates with the Conditional Use process.

- 3 Business Representatives (1 mile radius)
- 1 Individual with experience with homelessness
- 1 Representative from human service community

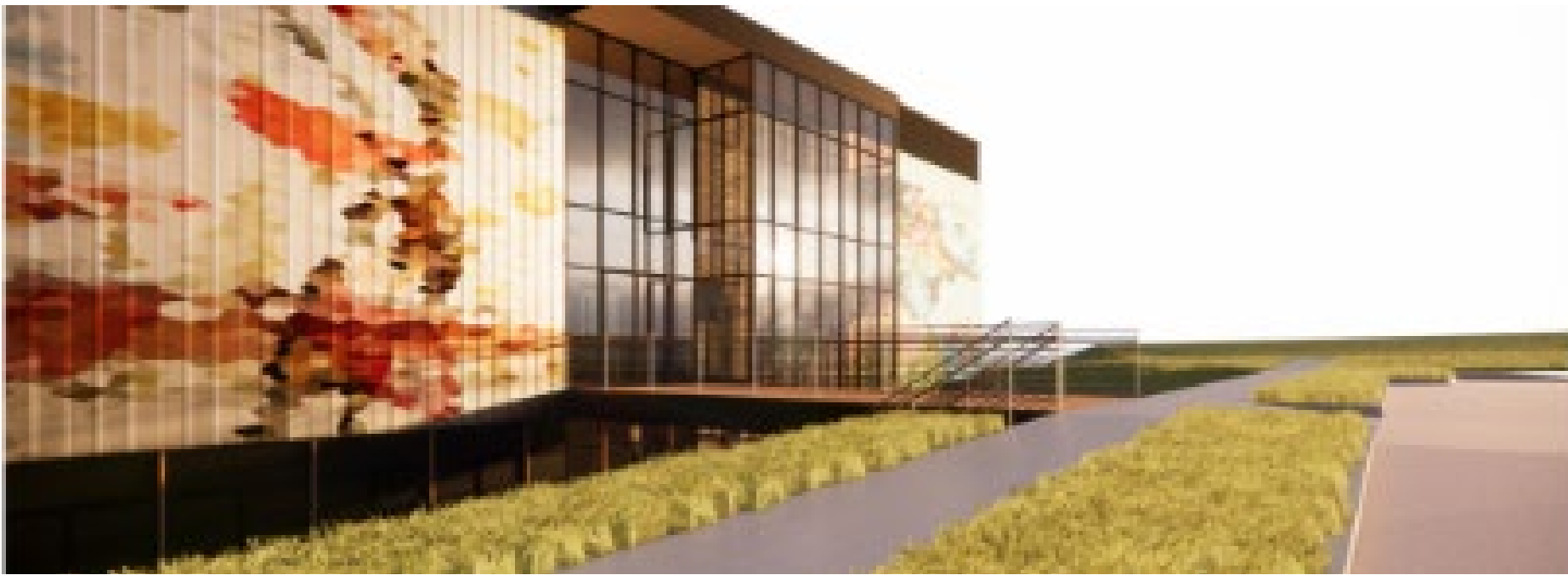
