ORDINANCE NO. 6572

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$641,600 in federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding to support the design and construction of the 2022 Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon Crosswalks Project at four separate locations; 2) amending the 2021-2022 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund to increase the appropriation by \$641,600; and, 3) amending the 2021-2027 CIP Plan to increase the budget for the Traffic Safety Improvements Program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-46) by \$641,600.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant
agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of
Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$641,600 in federal Highway Safety
Improvement Program (HSIP) funding to support the design and construction of the
2022 Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon Crosswalks Project at four separate
locations, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The 2021-2022 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 6557 on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$641,600.

Section 5. The City's 2021-2027 CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6557 on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the Traffic Safety Improvements Program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-46) by \$641,600.

Section 6. If the actual revenue received from Washington State Department of Transportation shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.
