## **Transportation CPAs**

## Multimodal Concurrency – Mobility Implementation Plan (MIP):

- Council has directed Transportation Commission to prepare a recommendation to broaden existing vehicle-focused concurrency standard to a multimodal approach
- CPA would amend or add policies in the Transportation Element to embed multimodal concurrency, including amending maps and narrative

## **Comprehensive Transportation Project List (CTPL):**

- CTPL was added to the Comprehensive Plan in the 2015 update to consolidate all transportation projects
- CPA would repeal the CTPL from the Comprehensive Plan
- CTPL would be replaced fully by the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) in 2022. Council updates the TIP annually to reflect planned projects.
