





Conformance Amendments



- Amendments to effectively integrate the proposed LUC section 20.25A.175 and ensure consistency with the broader Downtown Code
- Amendments to the definitions
- Change of right-of-way designation for 102nd Avenue NE, between Main Street and NE 1st Street, from a "B" to an "A" for consistency with the Grand Connection LUCA
- General clean-ups for clarity and to correct cross-references
