

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6578

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 6557, adopted December 14, 2020, as previously amended, to increase the appropriation to the 2021-2022 General Fund budget by \$1,355,000, which is offset by transferring the Council Contingency (G-107) budget as previously appropriated of \$1,355,000 from the Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund to the General Fund to allow Council priorities to proceed within the 2021-2023 timeframe.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 6557 adopted on December 14, 2020, the City Council adopted a fiscal biennium budget for 2021-2022 for the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to further amend the 2021-2022 biennium budget for the General Fund to advance Council priorities within the 2021-2023 timeframe, which is in the best interests of the City; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A finding is made that it is in the best interest of the City to further amend Ordinance 6557 to increase the appropriation of the 2021-2022 General Fund budget by \$1,355,000, by decreasing the Council Contingency (G-107) budget by that same amount in order to advance Council priorities within the 2021-2023 timeframe.

Section 2. Ordinance 6557, adopted on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to the 2021-2022 General Fund budget by \$1,355,000, which is offset by transferring the Council Contingency (G-107) budget as previously appropriated of \$1,355,000 from the Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund to the General Fund.

Section 3. This Ordinance has received an affirmative vote of a majority plus 1 of the Council.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
