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

Equity in the MIP

- Emerging area of emphasis in the City
- Guidance from the City Manager's Diversity Advantage Initiative:
 - The City will enact and uphold equitable policies and practices
 - Create a fair and just community where equality is the outcome, by recognizing and correcting historic and systemic inequity
- TR-21. Ensure that the transportation system infrastructure in Bellevue provides mobility options for all modes, and accommodates the mobility needs of everyone, including underserved populations.
- Equity is a key element of the MIP scope of work approved by City Council
 - The community benefit will be a more equitable and sustainable approach to identify, prioritize and fund transportation system projects.




How Equity Analysis Informs Transportation Planning in Tacoma

- Example from Tacoma
- Equity index based on 29 factors
- Identifies areas with higher opportunity (darker) and lower opportunity (lighter)

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 Helps focus city investments and resources



Process


ž Identify indicators



Data considerations:

- Availability
- Completeness
- Adjust to local conditions

Recommend using standard deviation to define the threshold for each indicator.

Apply to understand alignment with existing identified projects and incorporate into updated prioritization framework.


Typical Equity Indicators

- Limited English proficiency households


- Housing cost burden

- Low-income jobs

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
Map Categories











People with disabilities




Female heads of household




Limited English proficiency households




Housing cost burden




Vulnerable age groups (older residents)




Vulnerable age groups (younger residents)

Takeaways

- In general, the recommended indicators are suitable to include in the Mobility Implementation Plan equity index
- Explore ways to better capture specific indicators
 - Vulnerable populations (e.g., place-based rather than home based approach)
 - Housing cost burden: need to refine to ensure it is targeting populations in need

Equity Next Steps


- Finalize
