DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

Harborview Medical Center: Harborview Medical Center is a comprehensive healthcare facility owned by King County. Interim Chief Executive Officer Sommer Kleweno-Wally and Harborview Board of Trustees President Steffanie Fain will brief Council on Harborview's services and response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

No action is required from Council at this time. Tonight's presentation is an opportunity to learn about Harborview's services and ask questions.

LEGISLATIVE STATUS REPORTS

State Legislative Update: The 2021 state legislative session ended on Sunday, April 25. Since then, Governor Jay Inslee has taken action on more than 200 bills. The effective date of legislation passed in the 2021 session is July 25 unless specified otherwise in the bill.

Briahna Murray, Vice President at Gordon Thomas Honeywell Governmental Affairs, will provide an oral report on the 2021 state legislative session and Bellevue's legislative priorities. Assistant City Attorney Matthew McFarland will discuss two bills affecting City land use regulations and the anticipated process to bring the City into compliance with the requirements of those two bills prior to July 25. More information on bills of interest to the City is included in the written summary.

Federal Legislative Update: Staff provided a written summary of recent activities of the Congress and Administration.
