

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6588

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$350,000 in state Regional Mobility Program grant funding to support the Transportation Demand Management (TDM) and SchoolPool programs in state fiscal years 2021 to 2023; and, 2) amending the 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund to increase the appropriation by \$350,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$350,000 in state Regional Mobility Program grant funding to support the Transportation Demand Management (TDM) and SchoolPool programs in state fiscal years 2021 to 2023, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. At the time of execution of said Grant Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund into which all said respective grant monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for said grant monies is:

WSDOT Regional Mobility	\$350,000
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Section 6. Upon execution of said Grant Agreement, the budget for the 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating \$350,000 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said Grant Agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
