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

Equity Index Purpose

 Integrate equity considerations into transportation planning and prioritization of projects

 Identify populations that have been historically underserved and are most reliant on transportation options to get around



Equity Index Process




Equity Index Indicators & Weighting

Equity Indicator	Weight assigned in Index
Low-income households	30%
Zero-vehicle households	15%
People of colorLimited English proficiency households	10% (each indicator)
 People with a disability Low-income jobs Housing cost as a percentage of income (renter-occupied) Housing cost as a percentage of income (owner-occupied) People over age 64 People under the age of 18 Single-parent, female headed households 	5% (each indicator)

Equity Index Map

- The areas of the city with multiple disparity factors, and where transportation improvements and options would best promote equity, are darker
 - Crossroads, Bellevue College area, and Factoria
- This will help identify and prioritize transportation system investments in each update of the TFP

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

Figure 3. Percent of households with an annual income below \$35,000 in block group







Figure 5. Percent of single-parent households headed by females with children under 18 years old







Figure 7. Percent of population over the age of 64






Figure 9. Percent of households spending 50% or more of their annual income on gross rent




Figure 10. Percent of households spending 50% or more of their annual income on mortgage and housing related costs




Figure 11. Percent of households with employed residents aged 16 and over with no vehicle access
