

CPA Proposal

Repeal the Comprehensive Transportation Project List from Volume 2 of the Comprehensive Plan

Staff recommends to use the Transportation Improvement Program as the one comprehensive, citywide inventory of transportation projects to be considered for prioritization in the Transportation Facilities Plan

- Council updates the TIP annually, with a recommendation from the Transportation Commission
- Responsive to planning and engineering work
- Projects in TIP are eligible for grants!

CPA Decision Criteria

LUC 20.30I.150

- The proposed amendment is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan.
- 2. The proposed amendment *addresses the interests and changed* needs of the entire city.
- 3. The proposed amendment *addresses significantly changed* conditions.
- 4. The proposed amendment is not applicable to a specific site, therefore this criteria does not apply.
- 5. The proposed amendment demonstrates a public benefit and enhances the public health, safety and welfare.
