Objective of Ordinance No. 6586

- IOC is designed to bring LUC into immediate compliance with SB 5235
- SB 5235 effective July 25
- SB 5235 addresses local authority to regulate the number of occupants in a dwelling unit
- Permanent regulations are to be developed with Council initiation of LUCA



IOC Ordinance No. 6586



- Amend "Family" definition
 - One or more persons residing in a dwelling, operating as a single housekeeping unit (LUC 20.50.020)
- "Single Housekeeping Unit" definition
 - Remove requirement for single lease (LUC 20.50.046)
 - Clarify that this does not apply to transient lodging
- Single Family Dwelling accommodates one or more persons, operating as a single housekeeping unit

IOC Ordinance No. 6586

- "Rooming House" definition
 - Non-owner-occupied dwelling rented on an individualroom basis
- Remove limits for specific housing types:
 - ADUs (LUC 20.20.120.A.3)
 - Rooming Houses (LUC 20.20.700.A.2)
 - Maintains maximum of 4 rooms being rented




Related Codes

- Transient Lodging (Airbnb) only allowed in owner-occupied homes and with Home Occupation Permit
- Rooming Houses prohibited in single-family land use districts



- Bellevue Police and Code Compliance enforce traffic, parking, noise, and nuisance laws
 - Use MyBellevue app to report violations

Process for IOC



- IOC is effective for 6 months
 - Expires January 2022
- EBCC to hold hearing and act on IOC August 3
- Permanent regulations will be developed through LUCA process
