ORDINANCE NO. 6597

AN ORDINANCE (1) amending the 2021-2027 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to decrease the budget for the Surrey Downs Park Development (CIP Plan No. P-AD-95) by \$645,000; (2) amending the 2021-2027 General CIP Plan to decrease the budget for the Gateway/NE Entry Downtown Park (CIP Plan No. P-AD-100) by \$783,409; (3) amending the 2021-2027 General CIP Plan to increase the budget for the Newport Hills Park Development (CIP Plan No. P-AD-102) by \$1,428,409; and (4) awarding Bid No. 21070, the Newport Hills SE 60th Street Neighborhood Park project, to Terra Dynamics Inc. as the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, in the amount of \$2,935,750.00, plus all applicable taxes.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2021-2027 General CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6557 on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to decrease the budget for the Surrey Downs Park Development (CIP Plan No. P-AD-95) by \$645,000.

Section 2. The City's 2021-2027 General CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6557 on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to decrease the budget for the Gateway/NE Entry Downtown Park (CIP Plan No. P-AD-100) by \$783,409.

Section 3. The City's 2021-2027 General CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6557 on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the Newport Hills Park Development (CIP Plan No. P-AD-102) by \$1,428,409.

Section 4. Bid No. 21070, the Newport Hills SE 60th Street Neighborhood Park project, is hereby awarded to Terra Dynamics Inc. as the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, in the amount of \$2,935,750.00, plus all applicable taxes.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
