## Ordinance No. 6589

#### Land Use Code Amendment (LUCA):


- Amend LUC 20.20 General Development Requirements and 20.50 Definitions, as applied to the EBCC jurisdictional area
- Establish lower minimum parking requirements for certain housing developments within one-quarter mile of frequent transit service

#### **State Law**

 Conforms the LUC, as applied in the EBCC jurisdictional area, with RCW 36.70A.620 and

36.70A.698





# Frequent Transit Service Eligibility

Stops with service 2-4 times/hour	Stops with service 4+ times/hour
Permanent Affordable Housing	Market Rate Multifamily, Senior Housing, and Affordable Housing
1/4-mile radius applies	1/4 mile radius applies in EBCC jurisdiction
	1/2-mile radius applies elsewhere
	Include future light rail or bus rapid transit stops opening within 2 years

# **Legislative Process**

#### City Council Ordinance No. 6575

 Established reduced minimum parking standards and eligibility Citywide

#### EBCC Resolution No. 591

- Rejected Ordinance No. 6575, no change to parking requirements in EBCC jurisdiction
- EBCC out of compliance with State regulations

#### **EBCC Resolution No. 592**

- Clarified that the rationale for rejecting Ordinance No. 6575 was limited to expanding the transit stop radius from ¼ mile to ½ mile
- Declared intent to approve if new ordinance included ¼ mile

April 26	City Council Adopted Ordinance No. 6575
May 4	EBCC Disapproved Ordinance No. 6575 (Resolution No. 591)
July 6	EBCC clarified its disapproval (Resolution No. 592)
July 19	City Council Action
August 3	EBCC Public Hearing and Approval/Disapproval

# **Parking Ratios**

Same parking ratios as established with Ordinance 6575

Housing Type and Transit Access	2-4 Times per Hour	4+ Times per Hour
Affordable Housing (Up to 80% County AMI)	0.75 spaces/unit	0.5 spaces/unit*
Market Rate Multifamily	Not Eligible	0.75 spaces/unit
Senior Housing	Not Eligible	0 spaces/unit Only applies to parking for residents

<sup>\* 0.25</sup> spaces/unit for small units at 60% AMI
