Objective of IOC

- SB 5235 addresses local authority to regulate the number of occupants in a dwelling unit
- Effective July 25
- IOC designed to bring LUC into immediate compliance with SB 5235
- Permanent regulations to be developed with Council initiation of LUCA




IOC Ordinance No. 6586




- Amend "Family" definition
 - One or more persons residing in a dwelling, operating as a single housekeeping unit (LUC 20.50.020)
- "Single Housekeeping Unit" definition
 - Remove requirement for single lease (LUC 20.50.046)
 - Clarify that this does not apply to transient lodging
- Single Family Dwelling accommodates one or more persons, operating as a single housekeeping unit

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
- "Rooming House" definition
 - Any dwelling with rooms rented on individual basis
- Remove limits for specific housing types:
 - ADUs (LUC 20.20.120.A.3)
 - Rooming Houses (LUC 20.20.700.A.2)
 - Maintains maximum of 4 rooms being rented



EBCC Jurisdictional Area



Anticipated LUCA Schedule



- IOC is effective for 6 months
 - Expires January 2022
- Permanent regulations will be developed through LUCA process
- LUCA will be presented to EBCC at a courtesy hearing before Council adoption
 - EBCC to act on LUCA following Council adoption

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
