Equity Index: Indicators and Weighting


Indicator	Weight assigned in Index
Low-income households	25%
Zero-vehicle households	15%
 People of color Limited English proficiency households People with a disability Low-wage jobs (based on job location) 	10% (each indicator)
 Housing cost as a percentage of income (renter-occupied) Housing cost as a percentage of income (owner-occupied) People over age 64 People under the age of 18 Single-parent households 	4% (each indicator)
TOTAL	100%

Equity Index Map

Areas with multiple disparity factors are shown in darker colors

People in these areas may have a greater mobility and access disadvantage


