Key Insights

• Bellevue's key metrics continue to receive high ratings

Bellevue as a Place to Operate a Business - better/significantly better than other cities and towns	74%	74%	77%	79% (+2)
Quality of Services Provided to Businesses - somewhat/greatly exceeds expectations	66%	68%	72%	69% <mark>(-3)</mark>
Value of Services for Tax Dollar Paid– good value/excellent value for city tax dollar	N/A	59%	61%	66% (+4)
Likelihood of Recommending Doing Business in Bellevue – likely/extremely likely	57%	60%	58%	67% (+9)
Perceptions of Bellevue's Economy – better/significantly better than other Puget Sound cities and towns	92%	90%	91%	92% (+1)
Direction City is Headed - right direction	69%	69%	69%	73% (+4)

Business Health



- 80% of businesses state their business is "somewhat" or "very" strong
- 46% of businesses anticipate increasing capital expenditures
 - 36% anticipate increasing employment count
 - 16% anticipate increasing space leased or owned
- Key issues include the lack of:
 - Lack of qualified employees, and affordable housing and childcare for employees

Small Business



- 80% of small businesses rated Bellevue as a better place to do business than other cities and towns
- Small businesses rated their access to support organizations and service providers 11% higher vs. 2019
- Small businesses gave the City better quality of service ratings than large businesses
- 50% of small businesses identified the lack of affordable commercial space as the largest barrier to business
