NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **Bellevue City Council** will hold a public hearing during its virtual meeting at 6:00 PM on **Monday, November 15, 2021**, to consider the City of Bellevue's Proposed Modifications to the 2021-2022 Budget and 2021-2027 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan Mid-Biennium Update, including all proposed levies, taxes, fees, and rates. The agenda for the meeting will be published on or about **November 11, 2021**.

The public hearing will be held virtually via Zoom Webinar and is an opportunity for residents and other stakeholders to offer comment on any aspect of the existing or proposed biennial budget, including all levies, taxes, fees, and rates or the possibility of additional proposed modifications to the Mid-Biennium Budget, including possible future proposed levies, taxes, fees, and rates following the Public Hearing.
